LOCATION

Bistrita, residence of Bistrita Nasaud is located in Bistrita depression on lower course of the river Bistrita Ardeleana at altitude of 358 m , with the coordinates $47^{\circ} 10$ north latitude and $24^{\circ} 30$ east longitudine.

In the Bistrita is one of the most important urban medieval centers in Transylvania, noting the historic contoured the urban and architectural value. Among the architectural monuments that recall the Bistrita Citadel retains the Cooper Towerandfew fragments of walls. Sugalete Complex it consists of 13 buildings bunk connected by some spacious entries forming a gallery of 20 arches; Silversmith's House, the John Zidaru House-most oldest building in Bistrita, National College "Liviu Rebreanu" and National College "Andrei Muresanu".


Due to favorable geographical location, soil quality, rich forests and minerals, Bistrita-Năsădud lands have been inhabited since ancient times. Archaeological remains of the Neolithic, the Dacian, Roman and Roman Daco discovered in the county, is evidence of the permanence and continuity of the Romanian people on these sites. Also, documents in seconds. XIII-XV Gelu attesting to the principality, state party that included a large part of the present territory of the county (Salva, Mocod, Maieru, Rebra, etc.).
In medieval cities of Bistrita and Ciceu Rodna was heavily fortified and had old craft traditions and trade ties, and Bistrita Nasaud lands forming a bridge between Transylvania and Bukovina, to Moldova, the customs point of Rodna. Because of this Bistrita ranked fifth in the hierarchy of cities in Transylvania during the Middle Ages. Due to the important role played in the history of the development, is now the capital of Bistrita county.

From the twelfth century Romanian history, this area has strong interference with the history of Germans who came here brought arpadieni kings and the history of Hungary and later the Aus-tro-Hungarian Empire. During the empire in the Bistrita Nasaud and border guard regiments were formed from local people who were entrusted to be a shield for the eastern part of the empire and who enjoyed the privileges of the Empress Maria Teresa.

In Bistrita, Andrei Muresanu poet composed "Romanian Awake," the anthem of today's Romania, for which there is a house in the city municipal museum dedicated to the great Romanian patriot, and an imposing statue at the center of town, where celebrates every year the main national commemorative events.

Throughout history, Bistrita burg made the transition from German industrial city. Currently, an industrial city of Bistrita holds significant potential, a network of considerable commercial and tourist attractions for both visitors as Romanian and foreign.

Bistrita-Nasaud County has given the country a number of outstanding personalities, among whom mention Henry Wadsworth, Andrei Muresanu, Alan hanged, Gregory Moisil, Ion Pop Reteganu.

In Bram Stoker's novel, Dracula, the leading character, Jonathan Harker, visits Bistriţa and spends a night at the Golden Krone Hotel (Hotelul Coroana de Aur) on the eve of St. George's Day, before continuing his journey east to Dracula's castle. Although no such hotel existed when the novel was written, a hotel with the same name has since been constructed for visitors

## Evangelical Church

The greatest attraction of Bistriţa's Main Square (Piata Centrala) is the Evangelical Church built by Transylvanian Saxons centuries ago. Construction of this gothic church began in 1470 and was completed almost 100 years later by Petrus Italus de Lugano, who added renaissance elements to the structure. A 246 -feet ( 75 m ) steeple overlooking the city was added later, making it the highest stone church tower in Romania.

All National Team Official Participants (athletes and delegates) must check in BEFORE the start of the Technical Meeting November 10th 6:00pm). Any Official Participant not checked in by this deadline without notifying the Organizing Committee will be classified as an extra delegate and will be responsible for all his or her expenses.
Any judge, coach, or trainer who is not an Official Participant will be responsible for all his expenses. If your National Federation wishes to bring a judge, a coach or a trainer, it is recommended that your Federation nominate this individual to be an Official Participant for your Federation; otherwise, these individuals will be responsible for all their own expenses. The same rule applies for family members.

Any National Federations arriving before the official arrival date of November 10th and staying on after the official departure date of 13 th will be responsible for all their own expenses.

They will also be responsible for their own transportation between the airport and the hotel, if the arrival date is before. If you would like to stay additional days before or after the Championships, please contact the Organizing Committee who will be able to arrange a special rate.


Citizens of the EU as well as Iceland, Norway, Lichtenstein, and Switzerland don't need visa to enter the Romania Passport or ID is required only.
Other counties citizens may need a visa. A uniform Schengen (short-stay) visa allows its holder to stay in the Schengen Area for the duration identified in the visa, which can be 90 days at most. Information available at:

It is National Federations responsibility to obtain an entry visa for the country organizing the championship. All National Federations could ask for an Invitation letter either to the Championships Organizer or IFBB. The invitation letter does not mean you are granted your visa. IFBB and Championship organizer are not resposible of attendants visas.
To receive invitation letter, the applicant should forward the following information to the IFBB or Championship organizer :-A copy (scan) of passport.
If the visa not granted, the Cancellation Policies for the championship will still apply.
An athlete, who requested and received an invitation from IFBB Head Office or the Organizing Committee of an IFBB sanctioned event for visa purposes and usedthis visa to unlawful stay in the host country or any other country, will be subjected to the disciplinary proceedings and measures.

These Championships are open for All the IFBB affiliated national Federations from all over the world. Participation of athletes is limited to A-Team and B-Team from each country except the host country. Registration of athletes will only be considered if they are nominated by their IFBB affiliated National Federation.


The official arrival day is Friday, November 10th 2017.
The weight-in and registration of athletes will be conducted on Friday, November 10th 2017 between 10:00 and 21:00 hrs in the Metropolis Hotel.

All athletes will have to produce their Passports or Identity Cards and IFBB International Cards at the Official Registration. Any athlete who has not yet obtained the IFBB International Card or need to renew his/her Card will have to do it at the Registration. IFBB International Cards are EUR $30 €$ per year and are mandatory.

All posing music must be on an audio CD only. The posing music must be the only track on the CD. Each competitor must affix his name on the CD for an easy identification. The use of profane, vulgar and offensive language is strictly prohibited in the posing music.

REGISTRATION FEE

Each official participant of the Junior categories and the official delegates, including the delegates without competitors, must pay the Registration Fee of EUR $300 €$ Each official participant of the Masters categories, must pay the Registration Fee of EUR $300 €$ This fee has to be paid to the appointed IFBB official on arrival at the hotel or in advance throught the IFBB webpage

## B-TEAM :

Each participant of the Junior categories must pay the Registration Fee of EUR 300. Participant of the Masters categories, must pay the Registration Fee of EUR $300 €$

Each extra-delegates must pay the Registration Fee of EUR $350 €$
The Registration Fee of IFBB is completely independent of the security deposit of the hotel.

The rules regarding A and B teams for this event are as follows:
The „A"- team

- Each National Federation may enter an „A"- team.
- The maximum allowable number of competitors in the „A"- team is 36 (13 juniors + 23 masters).
- A maximum allowable number of „A"- team competitors per National federation in any one category shall not exceed two (2).
- Pursuant to applicable rules, the Organiser will provide free-of-charge accommodation, meals, onsite transportation between hotel and venue and access to the Prejudging, Finals and Farewell Banquet to all „A"- team competitors.
- National federation shall pay a Registration Fee for each „A"-team competitor
- The "A"-team competitors shall compete for placings and awards, including

Best National Team award

- A National Federation must fully declare its „A"- team competitors on the Final Entry Form (FEF) and must register the „A"-team competitors upon check-in the official hotel, failing which any undeclared competitor shall be responsible for all his or her expenses.

The „B" - team

- Each National Federation may enter a „B"- team according to the rules specified below.
- The maximum allowable number of JUNIORS competitors in the B-team shall not exceed those in the A-team ( 13 athletes);
-There is NO LIMITATION for „ B "- team MASTERS competitors in these Championships.
- The National Federation shall be obliged to pay the Full Package Rate for each „B"-team competitor. This package shall comprise of the competitor's
Registration Fee, accommodation, meals, onsite transportation, and access for Prejudging, Finals and Farewell Banquet.
- The „ B "-team competitors shall compete for placings and awards, including the Best National Team award.
- A National Federation must fully declare its „ $\mathrm{B} "$ - team competitors on the Final Entry Form (FEF) and must register the „B"-team competitors upon check-in the official hotel, failing which any undeclared competitor shall be disqualified.

JUNIOR <23 years of age


An athlete, male or female, may compete as a JUNIOR competitor up to and including December 31st of the year in which the athlete reaches his or her 23rd birthday.

## FEMALE MASTERS:

a) May compete as a MASTER competitor in the category 35-44 years of age from January 1st of the year in which the athlete reaches her 35th birthday up to and including December 31st of the year in which the athlete turns 44. From January 1st of the next year, she may compete only in the category over 45 years of age.
b) May compete as a MASTER competitor in the category over 45 years of age from January 1st of the year in which the athlete reaches her 45th birthday.

## BOODYBUILDING AND MEN'S PHYSIQUE MALE MASTERS:

a) May compete as a MASTER competitor in the category 40-44 years of age from January 1st of the year in which the athlete reaches his 40th birthday up to and including December 31st of the year in which the athlete turns 44. From January 1st of the next year, he may compete only in the category 45-49 years of age.
b) May compete as a MASTER competitor in the category 45-49 years of age from January 1st of the year in which the athlete reaches his 45th birthday up to and including December 31st of the year in which the athlete turns 49. From January 1st of the next year, he may compete only in the category over 50 years of age.
c) May compete as a MASTER competitor in the category over 50 years of age from January 1st of the year in which the athlete reaches his 50th birthday.

## PARTICIPATION

These Championships are open for the IFBB-affiliated National Federations. Participation of athletes is limited to A-Team and B-Team from each country, except the host country. Registration of athletes will only be considered if they are nominated by their IFBB-affiliated National Federation by sending the Final Entry Form with their names.
The deadline date for submitting the Final Entry Forms is October 23th, 2017.
The final decision to allow an athlete to compete in this event rests with the EBFF.


The Organizing Committee will maintain a Secretariat in the Executive Official Hotel Metropolis to start from 08:00 am till $18: 00 \mathrm{pm}$ from Friday November 10th on Monday November 13th. You may obtain information and assistance from the Secretariat.

Green Cards are used to limit access to the Weigh-in and backstage area during the Registration, Prejudging and Finals. They will be distributed at the Team Managers and Judges Meeting as follows:

- Eleven (11) or more competitors - three (3) green cards
- From six (6) up to ten (10) competitors - two (2) green cards
- Five (5) or less competitors - one (1) green card

If national federation officials do not attend the team managers and judges meeting, this federation will not be issued a green card.

## BACKSTAGE ACCESS/DRESSING ROOM ACCESS

Access to the backstage and/or dressing room areas shall be strictly limited to essential personnel only.
Coaches and trainers who assist athletes in the dressing room area must be of the same sex as the athlete they are assisting.

## CAMERA/VIDEOTAPE EQUIPMENT

Camera and/or videotape equipment shall be strictly prohibited in the backstage and/or dressing room areas except when used by IFBB-authorized media persons and, in any event, these devices shall be strictly prohibited in the dressing room area.

## PASSPORT/ MUSIC

All competitors must provide their PASSPORT and MUSIC at weigh in/ height measurement. The music must be on CD, at the start of the CD. The Athletes' name must be affixed on the CD for identification purposes

## The use of profane, vulgar and/or offensive language is strictly prohibited in posing music

All the National Federations must bring with them to Bistrita their National anthem (only brief version) in CD. This has to be on a separated CD with no other type of music on the $C D$. All the National Federations will have to take with them to Bistrita its National Flag. The flags must measure not more than 2.5 meters x 1.5 metres.

## Please Note For all the European Federations the IFBB already has a copy of all nationals anthems on CD.



The dress code for all Delegates and/or officials taking part in the Parade of Nations is the IFBB official uniform. The dress code for all athletes taking part in the Parade of Nations is posing attire. One (1) delegate per country must take part in the Parade of Nations

## DOPING CONTROLS

Doping controls will be conducted by the IFBB Medical Commission pursuant to the IFBB Anti-Doping rules, using a WADA accredited laboratory. In order to compete in the championships, all competitors at the weigh-in and registration will be required to sign a Drug Testing Consent \& Waiver of Liability Form (available in the appendix)

Doping controls may be conducted using any of the following methods:

- Random Selection: A number of athletes selected at random throughout the event e.g. at weigh-in.
- Weighted Selection: A number of athletes selected at random from among the top finalists e.g. at finals.
The IFBB reserves the rights to target test any athlete. The IFBB is a signatory to the WADA code. Participating national federations have a duty and an obligation to ensure that their national team athletes are competing drug-free at the IFBB international competitions.

To be taken into consideration during selection of judges panels at the Championships, IFBB International Judges (as well as test judges) must be included in the Final Entry Forms sent by National Federations, according to the IFBB Rules. All international judges must bring their international judge's cards to Bistrita.

## IMPORTANT NOTICE:

All judges who wish to be included in the judges' panels at these Championships should be specified in the Final Entry Form. The test judges should be specified there as well. Judges have to pay the yearly Judges' Licence Fee of EUR $€ 50$ for 2017. This fee may be paid at the Championships. Test judges should pay a test fee of EUR $€ 50$.
This fee may be paid at the Championships.
All judges must attend the Team Managers and Judges Meeting. If the above conditions haven't been met, judges will not be able to carry out their duties at the Championships.

## ATHLETES WITHOUT DELEGATES

All Athletes competing at these World Junior and Master Championships must be affiliated Members in good standing of their National Federations. Any Athlete who arrives without a Delegate must bring an Official Letter of Authorization of Participation from his National Federation, failing which the Athlete will not be allowed to participate.

Misrepresentation is a serious breach of the IFBB Code of Ethics and occurs when an "official" of a National Federation deliberately misrepresents the number of Athletes and Delegates so as to obtain free-of-charge accommodations, meals, onsite transportation, access to the Prejudging, Finals and other amenities at the expense of the Organizer.
Part of this misrepresentation may be a false claim that a person is an Athlete only to have that so-called Athlete fail to officially register as a competitor at the Weigh-in or, once having officially registered, fail to compete.
Any National Federation found guilty of misrepresentation will be immediately disqualified from the Championships and will be fined an amount equal to the Special Package Rate for each person involved.

## COMPETITOR INFORMATION FORM

This form must be completed by each competitor BEFORE coming to the weigh-in/height measurement and must be given to the IFBB Registrar at the registration table. This information is used to promote the competitor in the press, on TV, the website and other media.

## TANNING

The IFBB has banned all tans that can be wiped off. An official will check the tan of all athletes backstage and if the tan comes off by simply wiping, the athlete will be told to remove the tan before going on stage.

Once officially registered, no athlete may withdraw from competition without the prior approval of the IFBB chief judge. It is not accepted for a national federation to unilaterally withdraw an athlete without prior approval of the IFBB chief judge, who has the right to verify the reason for the withdrawal.


The final date to send the PEF is September 18th 2017. The national federations must email back the PEF to the organizing committee as soon as is possible but before the date limit, which confirms the intention of its federation to participate in the championship.
If at this moment you do not know the names official of the official participants she indicates the total number of athletes who will participate in the championship of their federation.

The deadline to send the Final Entry Form is October 23rd 2017

## FINAL ENTRY FORM (FEF)

 The National Federations must display the official names of all the participants (athletes by category of weight, the delegates and judges). It also must include the details of flights for arrival and departure.With the purpose of guaranteeing rooms for all the teams, the FEF must be sent before the date limit. Your cooperation is essential to guarantee your rooms in the hotel.

## FAILURE TO HONOR FINAL ENTRY FORM DEADLINE

Deadlines are set to assist the Organizer with arranging accommodations, meals, onsite transportation and other Championship activities. A failure to respect these deadlines is a breach of the IFBB Rules. If a National Federation fails to respect the deadline written on the Final Entry Form, each "Official Participant" from that Federation will be required to pay all of his or her own expenses, including accommodations, meals, onsite transportation, and access to the Prejudging, Finals and Farewell Banquet.

IF A NATIONAL FEDERATION FAILS TO SEND THEIR FINAL ENTRY FORM TO THE ORGANIZER AND ARRIVES IN BISTRITA WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE, THE NATIONAL FEDERATION WILL BE OBLIGED TO PAY A FINE OF EUR $€ 100$ PER PERSON.
